



Notice of overnight road closures, A361

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. As we reintroduce face to face engagement, which is in addition to the ongoing virtual engagement, we will continue to follow government guidance on reducing the spread of Covid-19. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we work within is our priority. What are we doing?

We are constructing a temporary bridge over the A361 Byfield Road, in an area north of Chipping Warden, close to our Chipping Warden Green Tunnel Compound. This bridge will enable our earthmoving equipment and other construction traffic to safely pass over the A361, reducing disruption on the highway.

At the end of July, we will require overnight closures on a section of the A361 where the temporary bridge abutments will be built. During these closures we will be carrying out reinforcement work and installing safety barriers. This overnight closure is required because our staff will be working directly on the carriageway and a signed diversion route will be in place.

When will these works take place?

The A361 will be closed overnight, 8.00pm to 6.00am, on Thursday 28 July and Friday 29 July 2022 with a signed diversion in place. The road will reopen at 6.00am on Saturday 30 July 2022.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as weather.

Duration of works

Works will commence Thursday 28 July 2022 for two nights.

Overnight working hours:
8.00pm – 6.00am

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

What to expect

Overnight road closures for two nights on the A361.

Access will be maintained for residents and emergency services.

What we will do

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

The map below, shows the overnight road closure on the A361 and the diversion route.

Our published diversion takes into account similar road types. Shorter routes may be known locally, but this route is compliant with traffic management requirements.
